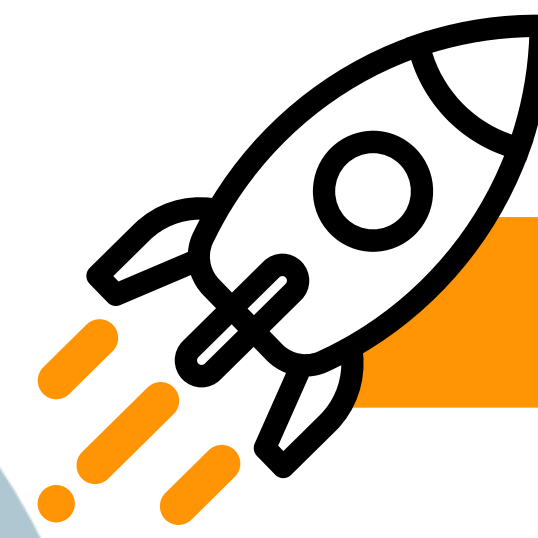
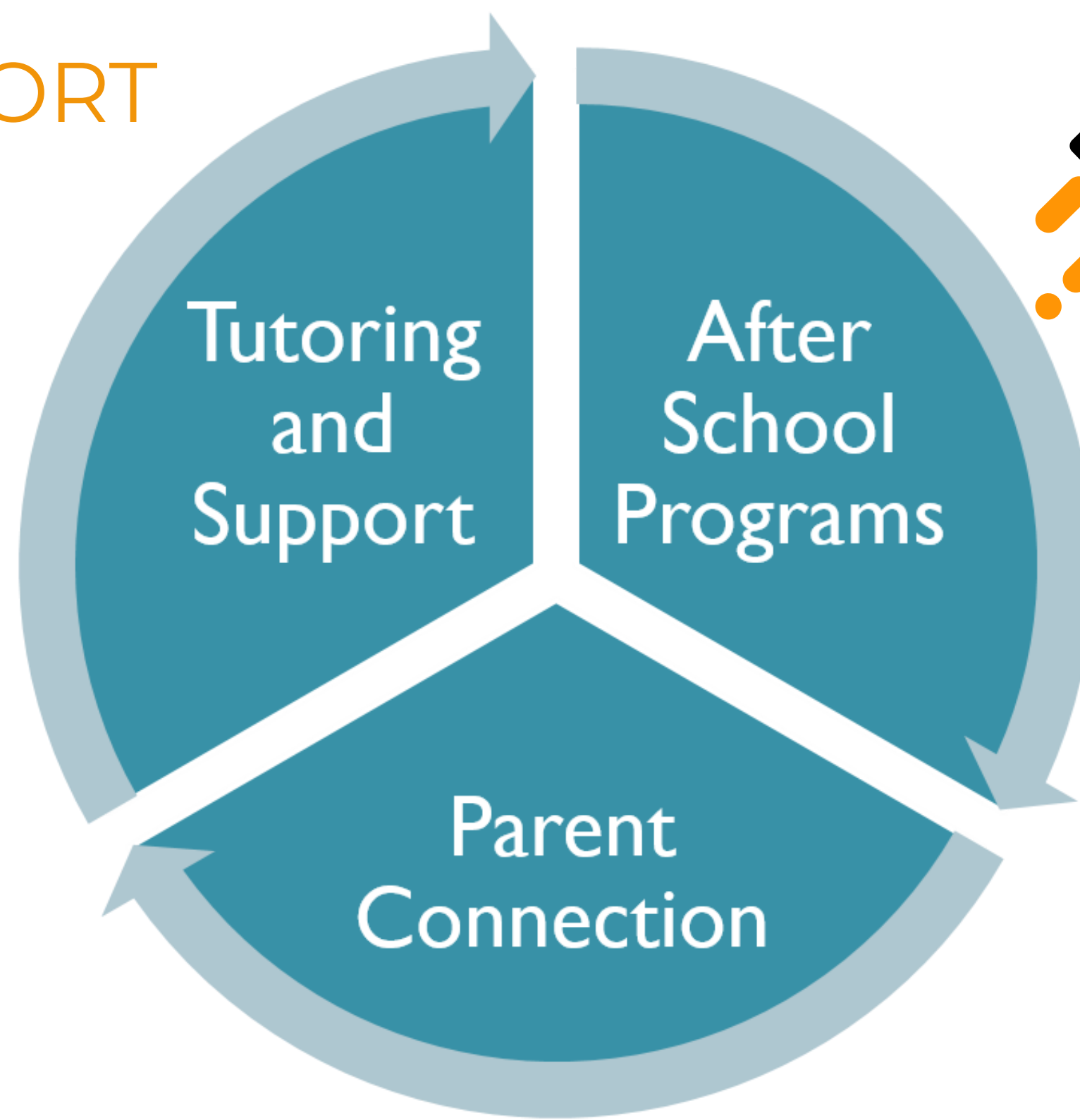
OUR MISSION To help students build the academic language skills needed to advocate for themselves and be able to use education as a means to reach their goals. *Our mission for members* is to build a learning community through service, reflection and inquiry.

DAY SCHOOL SUPPORT

Full-time members work closely with an ESL teacher to provide academic language instruction during the school day. **Part-time members** may also do this, depending on their schedule.

All members will provide a caseload of 5 to 10 students with -

- Academic Coaching (1:1 check-ins) on academic goals and skills;
- Push-in support to content classes (ie English Language Arts, Science, Social Studies or Math).



After School Activities

Members will lead or co-lead at least one (1200 hour members) or two (1700 hour members) after school classes at their school site. Activities may be enrichment based (cooking, sports, arts, theater, games) or academic (homework help).

Half-time (900 hour) members may or may not lead after school activities, depending on their schedule.







Family & Community Engagement

All members will maintain ongoing (twice per month) communication with families of their caseload students, and provide resources as needed to help families overcome barriers to engagement with school.

What commitment is right for me?

Regardless of the number of hours per week, **all members** must maintain a consistent school day schedule Monday through Thursday, plus be available for Friday training days.
